Meeting room 1 & New VIP Room

These light and contemporary rooms are ideal for a meeting, training day or seminar. They are also perfect as a break room for a large meeting. These rooms have fitted plasma screens that can be linked straight to a laptop, ideal for presentations.

Bar level 1

This contemporary space is located in the new foyer. It is a flexible space ideal for meetings, seminars, exhibitions and drinks receptions. This space also has a fully functioning bar so is ideal for after-meeting drinks and networking.

Bar level 3 and terrace

Situated at the top of the building with views across the city this space is perfect for an evening drinks reception, networking event or seminar. There is an abundance of natural daylight flooding in from the patio doors which give you direct access to the balcony. This large space with a fully functioning bar is the ideal location to relax and take in the views of Bristol.

Boardroom

Located in the old building the boardroom encompasses all the history of the Hall with a feature fireplace and panelled wall. The boardroom is the ideal space for more intimate meetings. Please note this room is not accessible for wheelchair users.

Hall 2

A beautiful high-ceilinged room situated within the classic surroundings of the old building. Hall 2 is the perfect space to give your delegates the wow factor, ideal for a product launch, exhibitions and larger conferences as the room has a technically equipped stage area.

Hall 1

Colston Hall's main auditorium creates an impressive setting for larger conferences and meetings. Seating up to 1,800 people, your guests will be able to soak up the atmosphere in this historic and much-loved venue.

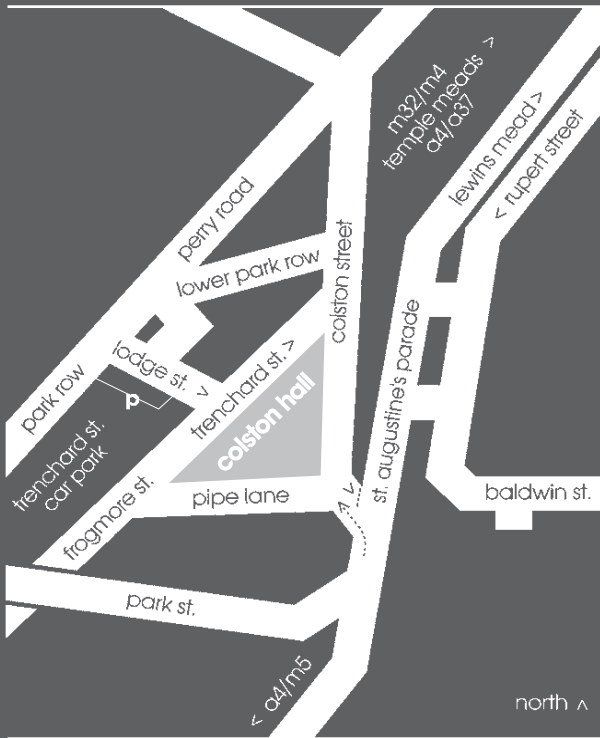
Extras and special touches

directions and how to find us

Located in the heart of Bristol's city centre and close to major transport links, Colston Hall is easily accessible by car and public transport.



By car

Via M5: Exit junction 18, follow A4 (Portway) to the centre.
At the promenade (St Augustine's Parade) turn left into Colston Street.
Via M4: Exit junction 19 (M32). Follow brown signs to the Hall.

Plentiful parking is available in the Trenchard Street car park located directly behind Colston Hall. Enter via Trenchard Street and Lodge Street.

By train

Bristol Temple Meads, the nearest station, is about a mile from Colston Hall. Buses 8 and 9 run directly to the city centre promenade. Call National Rail Enquiries on 08457 48 49 50 for train times.

By bus

Most city centre buses stop at the central promenade where you should alight for Colston Hall. For bus information, call Traveline on 0871 200 2233.
